George Crampton, camp director, has been the DeSales University head men's soccer coach for nine years leading the team to three Freedom Conference titles in 2005, 2006 and 2007 and into the first round of the NCAA playoffs. Named Freedom Conference Coach of the Year in 2004, 2005 and 2007,



Crampton, a Dublin native, played for the Republic of Ireland Amateur Team. His playing career in the US began at Mercer County Community College where he led the team to the NJCAA National Championship in 1991. At Elizabethtown College, he won two MAC Championships and was

named MAC MVP in 1994. Twice during his college career he was named an All-American. Crampton coached and played at the professional level for the Reading Rage. He holds the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) National, Advanced and Premier Coaching Diplomas, passing all with distinction. He is the Pennsylvania Technical Director and a National Staff Coach for the NSCAA.

John O'Rourke is the assistant men's soccer coach at DeSales. O'Rourke, a Dublin native, played for Mercer County Community College where he



was a regional All-American and All-Conference player. He holds the Irish Coaching License and the NSCAA National, Advanced and Premier diplomas and served as Director of Coaching for the Quakertown Soccer Club for four years. He is Territorial Sales

Manager, New Jersey/New York for KwikGoal Ltd., worldwide leader in manufacturing and distribution of soccer related products.

Mary Guarino is head women's soccer coach at DeSales. She played for Boston College and following graduation, Guarino was invited to play for the Women's United Soccer Association. She was signed and in 2002 won a W-League National Championship with the Boston Renegades. Guarino played semi-professional ball in the Women's Premier Soccer League with New York's Rochester Reign and Pittsburgh's Steel City Sparks. Guarino holds the National, Advanced and Premier diplomas from the NSCAA.



Lawrence Fine is one of the nation's premier goalkeeper trainers. He is founder and president of FineSoccer.com, an extensive online soccer coaching resource used by players and coaches around the world. He has published six books on soccer coaching including *SoccerAtEase*, *The FineSoccer Way to Coaching 9-12 Year Olds*, *Soccer 101 for Parents*, *The Goalkeeping Newsletter Archives* from FineSoccer, *The Soccer Newsletter Archives* from FineSoccer and *180 Games, Exercises, Drills and Activities* from Fine Soccer. 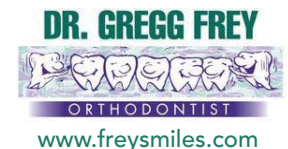
